Wellington Racqueteers Player/Member Code of Conduct

Creating a supportive and encouraging environment for members of the LGBTQI+ Rainbow Community to engage with Badminton at all levels

Note: This document should be reviewed on a regular basis prior to an AGM and should take into account the members' expectations also.

Wellington Racqueteers recognises Te Tiriti o Waitangi as Aotearoa New Zealand's founding document, and is committed to upholding the mana of Te Tiriti o Waitangi and the principles of Partnership, Protection and Participation.

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to set out the standards of behaviour expected of Players/Club Members. By paying fees and playing, each member agrees to adhere to this Code of Conduct at all times.

Everyone involved with the Wellington Racqueteers must:

Obey the Law at all times

Everyone is expected to:

- follow the principles of fair play, and encourage others to do the same
- respect the rights, dignity and value of others
- be considerate and treat everyone fairly and equally
- be a positive role model
- communicate with others in a way that is honest and considerate
- be committed to upholding a supportive sporting environment
- behave professionally, responsibly and ethically, at all times
- not behave in a way that is discriminatory, bullying, harassing, racist, sexist, violent, abusive or otherwise inappropriate towards others, in person or online
- play competitively and fairly
- play by the rules of Badminton
- be humble in both success and defeat
- be respectful of any officials/referees, coaches, team managers, teammates, and other competitors in any tournament environment
- be respectful of the staff of Badminton Wellington at all times
