Confirmation of Minutes from last year

Co-Chairs report

- The report was emailed to members.
- Craig summarised by saying that the club is doing incredibly well, we are still holding numbers and Wāhine nights are still very busy with 20+ people attending.



Financial update - Treasurer

- Big shoutout to Thomas James for his work and to Chris Anderson for taking over at short notice.
- Deficit - going ok \$5k to \$6k in account at any given time.
- Overall position unchanged.
- Costs are outpacing income, Shuttles, Court costs. Part of the issue due to chasing people up - gap of 3 months during cross over of Treasurers.
- It is proposed to increase membership fees
 - Annual up by \$30 to \$300 for once a week and \$430 for twice a week
 - Casual \$12.50.
 - Still a great deal compared to other clubs.

- We will also be more stringent of people paying up. Insisting people make payment before start of play. Occasionally we will have a committee member checking at club sessions to get money on time and make it easier to reconcile.
- Monthly subscription will not increase.
- Harun Ramanujam has connections and could get shuttles in bulk from Indian, will chat further after AGM.
- We understand that times are hard for some with the cost of living crisis, etc. and that some club members may have difficulty paying their subs from time to time. Please do not feel embarrassed about it and talk to a committee member if struggling and we will figure something out. We don't want anyone missing out.
- Annual subs are due by 31st May.

- Benjamin Lennard read out Ravi's report. Key take-away is that people were very happy with the socials offered, especially the Christmas/End Of Year Party that was paid for by the club.
